They may need to be individualized to meet the particular needs of a person with ASD!

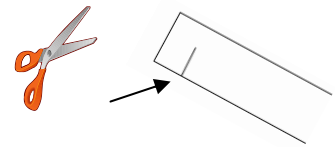


Time to Make Thanksgiving Figures!

Cut out figure



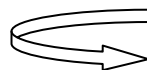
Cut a slit on each side of white strip
